CRITERIA FOR POST TAKE GERIATRIC WARD ROUND

Over 85 years

- We would expect to take all patients over the age of 85.
- **UNLESS** presenting with a single system medical disorder (eg chest pain, GI bleed).

Below 85 years

- Only appropriate if meet one of the following criteria or after discussion with the geriatrician of the day.
 - 1. They require the specialist care of a geriatrician for the following conditions;
 - a. Dementia
 - b. Stroke
 - c. Falls or fragility fracture
 - d. Delirium not related to alcohol or recreational drug use
 - e. Movement Disorder
 - f. Acute illness on a background of major multiple chronic comorbidities
 - 2. They would benefit from a multidisciplinary team approach for one of the following reasons:
 - a. Care home resident (residential or nursing)
 - b. Poor mobility or functional level with deterioration from baseline requiring therapy.
