

RUH – Maintenance Operative to Facilities Manager - Career Pathway

NB: It is possible to enter at any level with the appropriate employment, qualifications, skills &/or experience

Facilities Managers look after Operations and Departments or Specialist Systems and Procedures. Apprenticeships in management are available at Level 5-7.

Maintenance Technicians can progress to Service Managers and use apprenticeships at Levels 4 and 5 to support their development and registration with BIFM.

Maintenance Operatives can progress to complete a Maintenance and Operations Engineering Technician Apprenticeship Level 3.

All new Maintenance Assistants complete an induction and can start development through an apprenticeship as a Property Maintenance Operative Level 2.

Any progression beyond level 2 will require the achievement of English and Maths to a Level 2 equivalent (GCSE grade C, Functional skills level 2, Key skills Level 2, O Level grade C,CSE grade 1)
