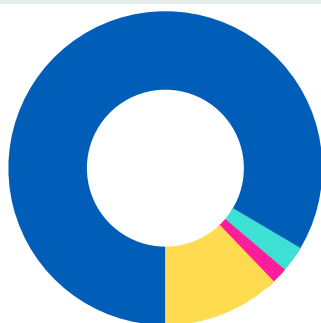

As of March 2023 we had **2508 members** of which **457 were new** library users.

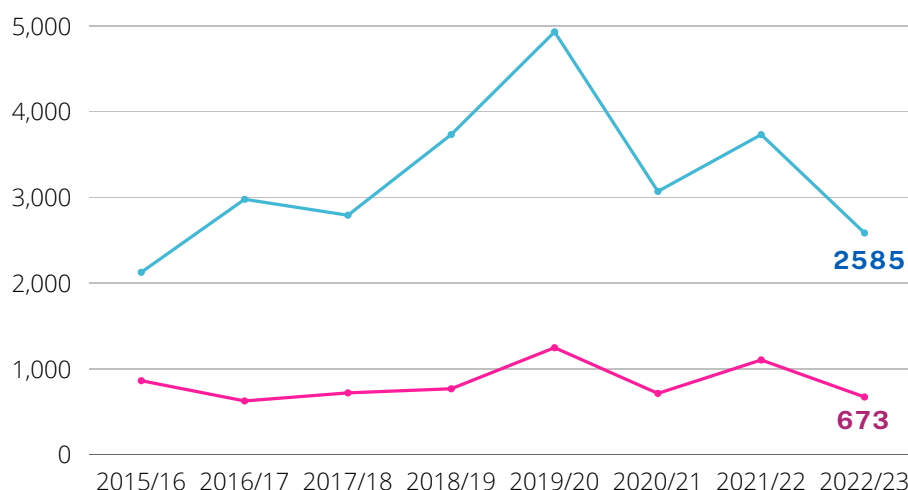
Information Searching
