2. Over temperature in wards and air-condition

Staff Governors accept the weather over the past few weeks has been unusually hot. The general consensus has been more needs to be done to ensure the working environment is tolerable given that this type of weather will become the norm.

3. Water dispensers

Some Staff do not have water dispensers in wards and department.

Recommendations

- Staff Governors recommend that the Council of Governors note the update report.
- The Council of Governors is asked to discuss their approach to car-parking issues. Are people using the local bus and other alternative route to work.
- The Council of Governors is asked to consider the installation of air-condition unit as its likely summer will continue to be hotter and are we exploring all options including solar panels.

- The Council of Governors is asked to seek if the Trust is promoting cycle to work.
