

Do You Need Roche Blood Gas Analyser Training?

Roche Blood Gas Analyser Training/Password Access

A blood gas training session must be attended and a competency completed and signed in order to obtain password access to the Roche blood gas analysers. Only trained staff are authorised to use the blood gas analysers.

Individual Training

- ❖ Arrange training with your local link trainer, your ward manager will know who this is.
- ❖ Attend a Wednesday session at 2pm (locations on schedule near blood gas analyser).
- ❖ Recertification – complete a competency form to be signed off by a competent user.

If unable to obtain training via a link trainer contact POCT

Induction/Group Training

- Provided by the POCT team.
- Usually organised by departmental managers/training officers.
- If you wish this to be organised for your department please contact POCT.
