SOP needed &amp; to go through some things still. JH to email 'risk' person in surgery.</li> <li>NICU/BBC gas analyser – BBC's down most of weekend which was clear, but can't find a full record of times when analyser down, only snippets, possibly not recording properly? POC staff can usually resolve problems in couple of hours. Basic guide won't cover all errors.</li> <li>EQA blood gas performance – several respiratory ward staff are trained but more required to be.
