

Buy a Brick with Bath Sands



Place a commemorative brick paver engraved with your baby's name in the Bath Sands Garden at Haycombe Cemetery in Bath

An opportunity to remember your baby in the peaceful setting of Haycombe Cemetery, Bath. The **Bath Sands Garden is** being created by bereaved parents as a gathering place for anyone affected by the loss of a baby.



The focus of the Bath Sands Garden is a brick circle of commemorative pavers. The brick circle will be surrounded by benches and planting, and there will be a sculpture at the centre. The garden looks out at a view of hills beyond the Cemetery.

The paver is a terracotta red brick paver engraved in gold. It will be set with other pavers in a circle on the ground.

The first brick pavers will be installed in May 2019 at the formal opening of the Garden. Prior to this time, the Garden will still be in progress.

The suggested donation for a commemorative brick paver is £40. You are free to pay less or more as you desire. The funds raised will help develop the Garden and contribute to the work of Bath Sands.


Please order your paver by March 1st 2019 for the May installation.
