Please could you therefore provide a regular supply of clean pyjamas and daytime clothes. T

his will help your relative to maintain a sense of individuality and selfesteem throughout their hospital stay.

Footwear is also important for patients who will be getting out of bed. It promotes safety and confidence when moving from bed to chair or around the ward. Slippers or shoes are acceptable depending on your relative's preferences.

A set of toiletries is also required including razors for men (disposable or electric). Do not worry about towels and flannels as we will provide these.

If you need further details about which items are necessary, please speak to either the nurse or the health care assistant looking after your relative.
