

Advice after having your Pinnaplasty

It is very important that your bandage stays on until you come to your outpatient appointment.

There are some stitches behind your ears. These will be taken out at your outpatient appointment.

It is a good idea to take some Calpol (paracetamol) before your appointment.

You will need to stay off school until your bandages have been removed.

Take paracetamol if you have any pain (do not exceed the recommended dose).

DO NOT TAKE ANY MEDICINES WHICH CONTAIN ASPIRIN

If you get a temperature or a lot of pain, please see your GP.

If you cannot contact your GP and are worried – please ring the nurses on the ward.
