


## PolyMem®

A breathable dressing to manage and assist in healing of wounds.

## Instructions for use

- Clean the area of skin with cooled boiled water to which a pinch of salt can be added if required.
- Using clean scissors; cut the dressing slightly larger than the wound (ensuring it covers any inflamed areas too).



- If the wound is dry; moisten the dressing before applying it.
- Apply printed side up, Secure the dressing using tape or dressing.
- Keep the dressing dry.
- Outline the wound on the dressing.
- When fluid becomes visible through the dressing; replace before fluid reaches the wound margin.

During the healing process the wound may appear to be larger during the first couple of dressing changes – this is normal – if it continues speak to the radiographers or your doctor.
