

How to complete your Rheumatology clinic assessments online

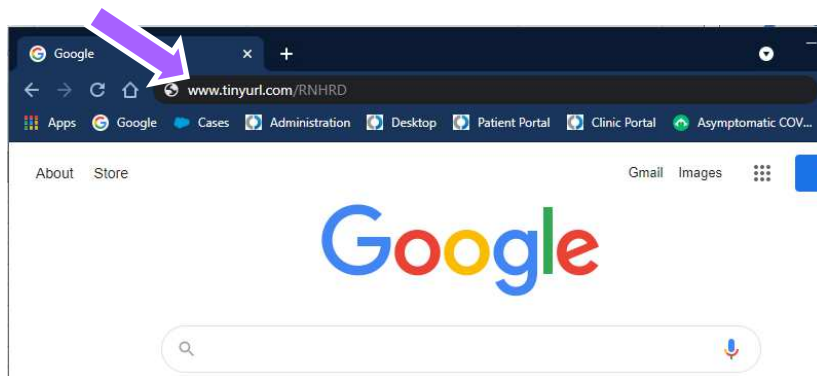
When you were given your clinic appointment you were also asked to complete some questionnaires online. This guide will show you how to do this step by step.

Getting connected

Use the link in your clinic letter or the card you were given in clinic to connect to the Patient Portal.

The best way to use this link is on a PC, laptop, iPad or tablet. The site is not very stable on a mobile phone.

Open up an internet browser, Google Chrome or Firefox work the best. Type the link in the address bar at the top or use this QR code



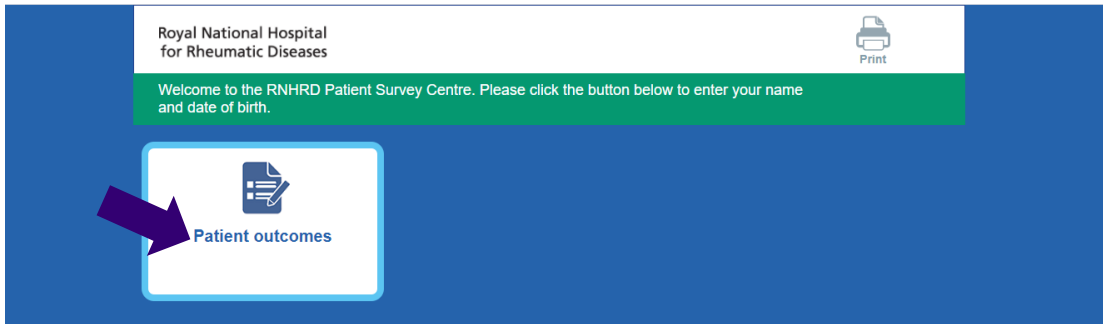

Completing your questionnaires

Once you have entered the link you will be taken to this page, click on the Patient outcomes button. This might take a few minutes to load while it checks for the latest forms.



1. On the next screen enter **your name, surname and date of birth** as shown in the example below and click on Search:

2. Click on a questionnaire and answer all the questions



- When you have answered the last question click on the complete survey button. This will save your answers and send them straight to your medical records.
