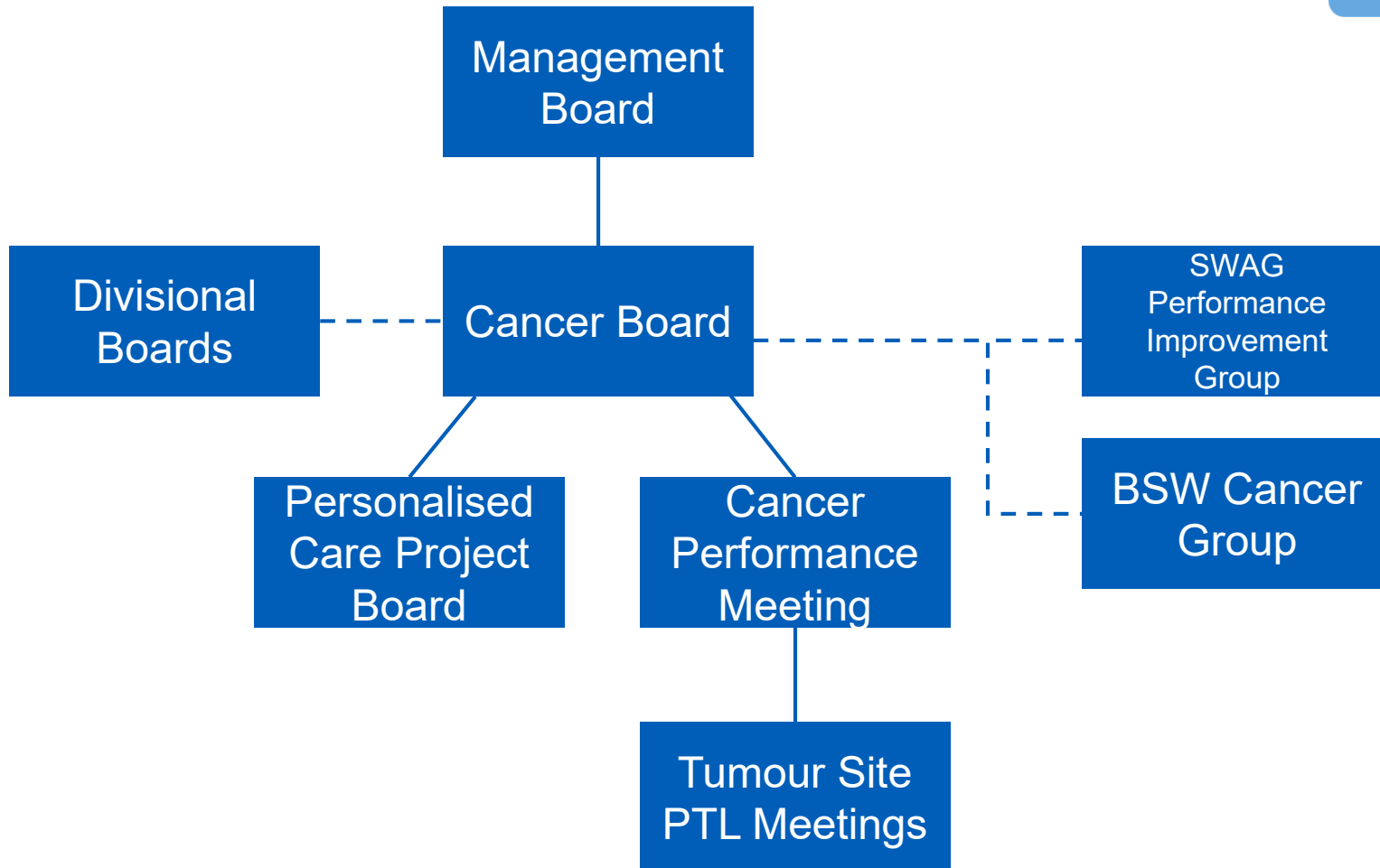

# Cancer statistics

1 In 2 people in UK born after 1960 will develop cancer in their lifetime (CRUK 2019)

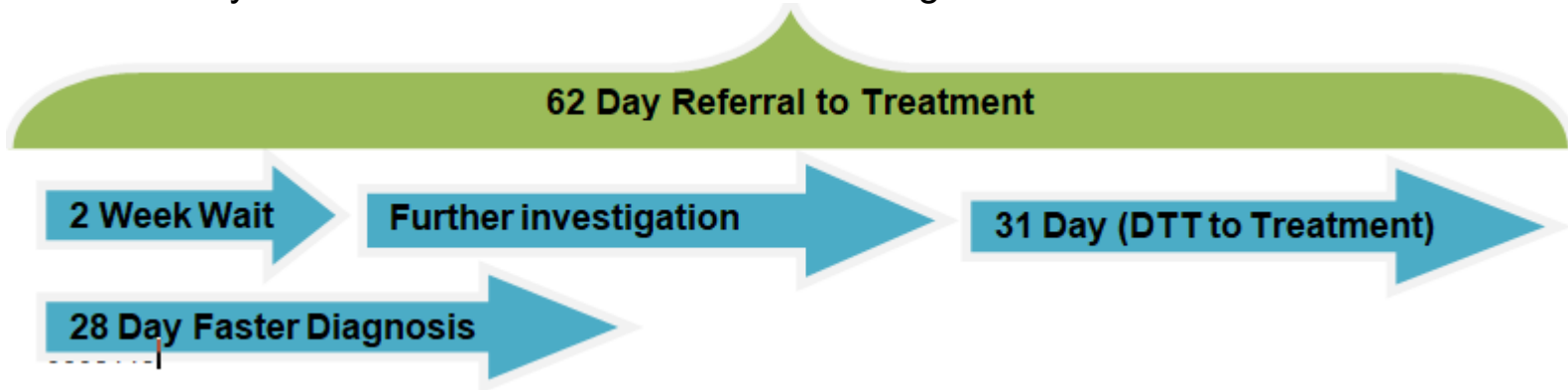
2.5 million people living in UK with cancer in 2015

4 million people living with cancer in UK by 2030 (Macmillan 2015)



## Cancer Waiting Time targets

- 2ww GP and breast symptomatic
- 31 day first and subsequent targets
- 62 day GP referral to treatment and screening



- 28 Day Faster Diagnosis Standard – go live October 2021
- Rapid Diagnostic Services

## Pandemic response

- Transfer of services to Bath Clinic and Circle
- Re-evaluation of diagnostic, staging, follow-up and chemotherapy strategies
- Weekly SWAG prioritisation/mutual aid meetings
- Weekly BSW meeting
- Weekly RUH operational prioritisation meetings
- Breach reporting, clinical harm reviews and evaluation
- Cancer and Diagnostic “Hackathons”
