- Maternity- work on Informed Consent moving forwards with Multi-Disciplinary Team Working Party, ongoing improvement work and focusing on this as a priority area for insight work
- Maternity- focusing on skill mix due to high numbers of new starters and experienced staff moving to specific new roles

RISK: Advise the board which risks where discussed and if any new risks were identified.

 New risks to be considered around paediatrics and mental health, work ongoing to review additional oversight needs and appropriate process for this

CELEBRATING OUTSTANDING: Share any practice, innovation or action that the committee considers to be outstanding

- Tissue Viability- medical devices related pressure ulcers reduced by 50% through improvement work and A3
- Tissue Viability- last year, 17 wards were pressure ulcer free
