It is great to know that we have a mutually beneficial relationship with Hilton Bath City that gives us the opportunity to fundraise each year through their annual charity ball. "We are looking to invest the funds already raised into our Paediatric Assessment Unit. We are looking to purchase another trolley bed and portable oxygen saturation monitors to help towards increasing the efficiency of the unit.

The funds raised at the Hilton Bath City hotel's charity ball were donated through the DM Thomas Foundation for Young People a charity that works to transform the lives of young people.
