RUH Having an MRI scan

Before having a scan the Radiographer will talk to you.

You and your parents, or carers will need to put all the things you have in your pockets and any jewellery into a locker.

You may need to get changed into a hospital gown.



The MRI scanner is a very large magnet.



The scanner is very noisy, so you will be given headphones to wear.

We can play music during the scan - you can bring your own CD or pick one of ours.



If you are having a scan of your head you will wear a special helmet!



A parent can stay with you during the scan.



They will wear headphones too!
