

Hydrocortisone Cream 1%

Hydrocortisone cream 1% is a cream that is applied to the skin to soothe inflamed skin in the treatment area.

Instructions for use

- Clean the area of skin with cooled boiled water to which a pinch of salt can be added if required.
- Ensure there is no powder in the affected area.
- Apply to sore/itchy areas of your skin.
- Apply sparingly twice a day, morning and evening may be beneficial.
- Wash your hands after each use.
- Do not use with any other creams or lotions for 2 hours following application of hydrocortisone cream.
- STOP using immediately if your skin breaks.
- You can use hydrocortisone for more than 7 days but no longer than 4 weeks.
- STOP using hydrocortisone when your symptoms stop.
- Can be stored in the fridge.
