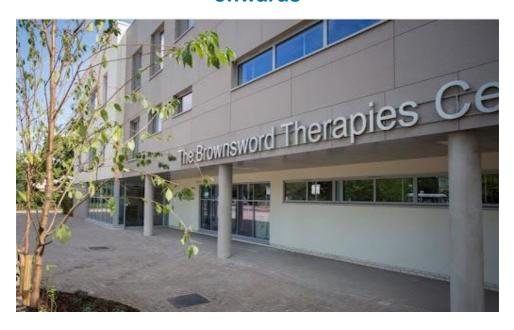

Prehabilitation

Prehab to Rehab, from your diagnosis onwards



What is Prehabilitation?

Prehabilitation (prehab) is a way to prepare your mind and body ahead of future cancer treatment. We know that being diagnosed with cancer can be worrying and overwhelming, but making small changes now can make a big difference to the way that you respond and recover from cancer treatment.

Research shows that you can build muscle and improve your fitness within 2 weeks

Building your physical strength and psychological wellbeing before treatment can help to maximise your treatment effect and reduce further problems and side effects.

What does prehabilitation involve?

- Improving nutrition by 'eating well', focusing on variation & balanced meals
- Increasing physical activity, this can range from gentle walking or gardening to more intensive exercise
- Looking after your mental wellbeing
- Giving up smoking and cutting down on alcohol
